

## **Literacy & Numeracy Catch Up Funding Report 2014 - 15**

### **What is the Year 7 Catch Up Grant?**

The Department for Education provides additional funding to secondary schools for those students who join in Year 7 not having achieved at least level 4 in Reading and/or Mathematics at the end of Key Stage 2 (KS2). In 2014/15 this grant was £500 per student. This money is allocated by schools to provide interventions which will help those students catch up in English and Maths with their peers.

### **2014/15**

On joining HTC in September 2014 16\* Year 7 students had achieved less than Level 4 in English and 19 in Maths at KS2. (\*One student left in Y7)

### **How the money was used**

The grant funding contributed to the provision of additional teaching staff in English and Maths along with SEN support where appropriate. This included (as appropriate) Literacy Intervention of Small Group Teaching, In class provision, AcceleRead AcceleWrite, Paired Reading, Reading Reflex, Read-Write Inc, Shared Reading and 1:1 Literacy Intervention as appropriate. Numeracy Intervention included WRAT activities and 1:1 intervention and catch up. These interventions are being continued into Year 8 as necessary.

### **The impact of the spending**

Within the Reading coaching programmes the average gain was twice that of students not receiving any specific literacy intervention. This means that on average these students are closing the gap with their chronological age faster than those who do not receive specific intervention.

At the end of the Summer term Literacy and Numeracy students showed the following progress:
